1. Now City Information is Live Streaming in “d button” by Shizuoka Asahi TV

Inquiry: Attractiveness transmission section at (82)4147

How to watch #01:

Push the “d” button. Once the date broadcasting screen is shown, navigate to Gotemba public information and push enter on the TV remote.

- “d” button
- *If your post code hasn’t been registered yet, you will see a message saying “SATV Municipality public information. Navigate to this instead and push the enter button. Choose “Gotemba City” from the municipality table list using the up-down buttons on your TV remote and push “enter”.

How to watch #02:

Navigate to your favorable information using the up-down buttons on your TV remote and check.

- The information on the display screen is an image
- Please contact the department in charge directory shown in Gotemba public information for any inquiries.

After pushing the “d” button, programs linked with data broadcasting shows as seen in “how to watch 01” will appear (sample picture is shown above) once you push the yellow button on your TV remote.

- Place: Kiramesse Numazu (Otemachi-cho, Numazu city)

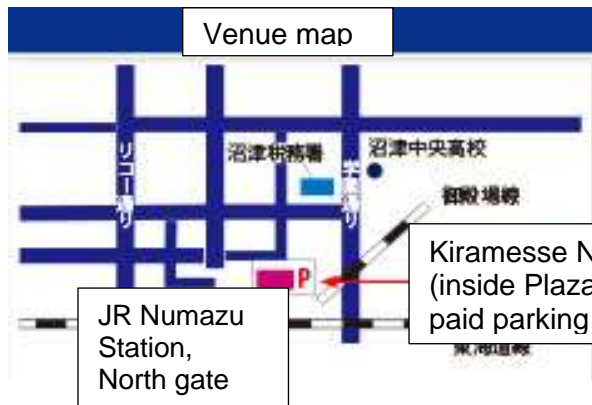
