Group vaccinations for rabies will be carried out. Please come to your place of convenience. In the case of inconvenience or your dog's condition, you can get your pets vaccination at veterinarian clinic. Please check the Japanese Koho-Gotemba for the schedule.

- Things to bring: ①Dog card (dog handbook), ②Notification postcard
③3,500 yen for Vaccinations per dog.
- Reminder:
 - If this is your first time registering, you need 3,000 yen per dog.
 - Please come with someone who can handle your dog.
 - Prepare the correct amount of money so there is no need for change.
 - The program will be held even if it's raining.
 - Please cooperate with corona prevention by wearing a mask when visiting.
